


- \* Young children can be strangled by loops in pull-cords, chains and tapes, and cords that operate the product.

- \* Head rails of internal blinds with pull cords shall not be installed less than 1.5m from the floor
- \* Do not use if any part is missing or damaged. The release of small parts from this product could result in choking hazard of children.


# **01**. Fitting brackets




Note: 1) Please ensure the correct wall plugs are used to suit your wall type. Wall fixing kit supplied suit for solids walls. 2) Center bracket [02] will only be supplied in blinds over 85cm. See components for reference.








B. Fixed outside window recess



C. Celling fixed




Note: The blind should be positioned centrally within or above the window recess. Use the tape measure and spirit level to ensure all bracket positions are accurate and level.

# centre support

Note: For single support bracket, position centrally. For two support brackets, space evenly between end brackets. Ensure brackets are fitted to the same height horizontally


### 02. Move cord stoppers

A.Slacken the cord around the safety stoppers allowing them to be moved down the cord.




B.Move cord stoppers 2-4cm above cord consolidator to fully lower your blind.

### 03. Place the Blind into brackets




Close cover on both end brackets.






Hook valance clip onto valance groove first then hook onto head rail as above picture shows.



 Choose suitable method A or B for your blind.


A. Fitting bottom bar retaining clips inside window recess.



# 06. Shorten your blind

Caution: Goods can not be returned after customizing check all size before you cut or modify any parts.

The Height: When the blind is fully lowered, there should be no slats over lapping at the bottom of the blind. If over lapping occurs you can remove slats to allow a custom fit.

07 . Fitting cleat

Children can strangle if this device is not installed and adjusted. Read carefully the instructions and install accordingly. Head rails shall not be installed less than 1.5m from the floor.

A safety device is fitted to the cords of this blind, it will open


and release of this blind, it will open and release the cords if something becomes caught in the cord loops.

To re-assemble after the cords have been released, or after shortening the cords, re-insert the cords into the device as illustrated fig.01.


Please ensure there is a knot on the end of each individual cord before clipping the device back together. It is mandatory to use the cleat provided in this pack during

the installation of this blind. The cleat should be adjacent to the blind and not less than 1.5m from the floor.

Test the device if not used regularly and replace the device if it is faulty.






# Storage, handling and transportation

When in storage, keep the products in a dry and ventilated place.

# **Fitting**

From time to time, check to ensure the screws remain tight. Frequently examine the installation for signs of wear or damage to cords.

Do not use if broken and repair is necessary.
